The Vice-Chancellor extended a warm welcome and thanked the members for sparing their valuable time for attending the meeting.

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The following items were taken up for consideration:

 Agenda Item no. 9/1: To confirm the minutes of the last meetings of the 8thAcademic Council held on 7th & 8th September 2016.
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Resolution No. AC/9/1: Resolved that the Council confirmed the minutes of the 8thmeeting of the Academic Council.

2. <u>Agenda Item no. 9/2</u>: To confirm the minutes of the board of studies for various Diploma courses for Police Personnel.

Resolution No. AC/9/2: Resolved that the members of the council discussed the syllabi for the various courses. The syllabi were appreciated and a common suggestion for all courses was given that the course material should be prepared in Hindi, and the list of suggested reading be expanded by including more Hindi books.

The changes suggested for each course are as follows:

(i) Diploma in Policing, Law and Investigation:

Suggestion: In the pattern for conducting diploma program, it was suggested that the number of candidates per program be 30 and this be taken for all courses.

(ii) Diploma in Forensic Science and Crime Scene Management :

Suggestion: Number of contact hours should be increased and Workshops / Seminars to be included in the curriculum.

Correction in page no. 20 "Total number of paper: 6"

(iii) Certificate Course in Intelligence Management:

Suggestion: In the pattern for conducting the certificate program the duration of the program is 3 months. The members also suggested that the course should be more practical based, and the intelligence collection mechanism of Rajasthan should be included. The functions and working of agencies responsible for intelligence collection, the structure of agencies and the coordination between the central agencies and state agencies should be included.

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One of the members has volunteered to help for the preparation of course material. It was also suggested that an agreement with the state police training centres be made so that more nominees for the course can be attached, where they can study the material and exam be conducted by the University.

(iv) Diploma in Correctional Administration :

Suggestion: It was suggested that the syllabus of this course should be checked again by Competent Officer's of this field.

- (v) Certificate Programme in Cyber Forensic (CP-CF):
 Suggestion: In the pattern for conducting the Certificate Programme, it was suggested that lab work/practical training must be minimum 18 hrs. and teaching of minimum 12 hrs.
- (vi) Advanced Cyber Defender Certificate Programme:
 Suggestion: In the pattern for conducting the Certificate Programme, it was suggested that lab work/practical training must be minimum 18 hrs. and teaching of minimum 12 hrs.
- (vii) Certificate Course in Gender Crime and Criminal Justice :

Suggestion: The members suggested for restructuring and re-naming of the course as "Certificate Course in Gender based violence in women." It was further suggested that Gender based violence to be taken up in an extensive method. Help from the training module of BPR&D's "Crime against women" be taken.

(viii) Certificate Programme on "Human Rights standards for Police":

Suggestion: It was suggested to re-send the course material to all the members.

Correction in point no. 3 part (iii) "Rights of accused."

Point - 4 (i) Police & Human Rights.

(ix) Certificate Course in Corporate Crimes, White Collar Crimes and Regulatory Offences:

Suggestion: It was suggested that the course should be sent to Competent Officers in the field. Once the course is approved by officers it can be started.

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It was further suggested that a programme should be prepared for the investigators of economic crime in the name 'Investigations of Economic Crime.'

(x) Certificate Course on Juvenile Justice:
 Suggestion: It was suggested that the nodal officer must contact the Centre for Child Protection and prepare again including JJ Act, POCSO Act and PCPNDT Act.

- (xi) Certificate Course on Transnational Crime, Security and Criminal Justice:
 Suggestion: It was suggested that the nodal officer must discuss with Coordinator, Centre for Peace and Conflict Studies and prepare the course material again.
- (xii) Certificate course in Cyber Law :

Suggestion: It was suggested that a new course should be prepared with the name "Cyber Forensic & Investigation." It must be a 6 months course and help from Gujarat Forensic Sciences University and Forensic Science Laboratory of Rajasthan be taken.
